The official name of our group was decided at 8:34 P.M. SACXS.

Our purpose is to increase the knowledge of, to propagate, to identify to preserve endangered species and to encourage others to do the same.

National membership to the Journal is \$12.50, as a group the fee is 10.00 SACXS dues were decided to be: Primary member \$5.00, Associate member \$2.50, thus making SACXS and CSSA dues annually beginning Jan. 1, 1978 to Dec. 31, 1978, \$17.50 for 2 of the same residence.

Those members having joined SACXS at our last meeting will owe \$10.00 to be a member of CSSA at the discounted rate of \$10.00 a savings of \$2.50. Those members joining after Jan. 1, 1978 SACXS and CSSA will receive all the back issues of the journal.

It was also decided that SACXS executive committee will consist of the Pres., V.-Pres., Sec., Treas., three directors.

Our monthly meetings will be the 3rd Wed. of each month. Meetings shall consists of a Social Hour beginning at 7:00 P.M. to approximately 7:45 P.M. followed by a program and then a business meeting. The Pres. shall preside at all meetings, the Vice-Pres. shall serve as program chairman and serve in the presidents absence. The Treasurer shall be in charge of all funds, keep a record of receipts and disbursements and report at each meeting. The Sec. shall keep a record of the proceedings and report at each meeting. Amendments or By-laws may be altered or ammended by a two-thirds majority of the society membership or of a quorum at a regular meeting provided that a reading of the proposed amendment has been made at the previous months meeting. It was proposed that at the Nov. 16, 1977 meeting we vote on the actual date of the Dec. 1977 monthly meeting.

Shirley Shead was gracious enough to extend her home for the Sept. 21, 1977 meeting. Executive meeting was held at 7:00 P.M. at the home of Ed Droste on Aug. 30th. The elected officers of the Aug. 17th meeting will serve until Dec. 31st, 1978. Meeting adjourned at approximatly 9:45 P.M.
